We are pleased to announce that the 25th annual C.J. Davidson Memorial Lecture Series will feature international speaker and Past President of the International Dyslexia Association, Dr. Eric Tridas.

Dr. Tridas is the recipient of the 2017 International Dyslexia Association Margaret Rawson Lifetime Achievement Award and the 2012 IMSLEC Innovator Award. This in-person event will be hosted by The Scottish Rite Learning Center in Lubbock, Texas, on February 25, 2022.

Dr. Tridas practiced developmental and behavioral pediatrics in the Tampa Bay area for 37 years. He is a member of the National Joint Committee on Learning Disabilities as well as the Professional Advisory Board of the Learning Disability Association of America. Dr. Tridas is a Clinical Associate Professor in Pediatrics at the University of South Florida. He lectures and consults nationally and internationally.

Part 1: The Perfect Storm – Inattention, Dyslexia and Anxiety

Dyslexia, ADHD and anxiety often coexist. During this presentation, Dr. Tridas will discuss the main contributing factors to a student's struggles and how they interact with each other to impair learning. He will review the symptoms of ADHD and anxiety as well as their impact on executive function and reading.

**Part 2: Imperfect Solutions – The Multidisciplinary Management of a Child
with Inattention, Dyslexia and Anxiety**

Dr. Tridas will provide a practical review of management of ADHD and anxiety for non-medical professionals. In addition, he will discuss different strategies to help address executive function challenges when instructing students with dyslexia and other literacy challenges.
